

**Central Water Authority (Water Supply for Non-Domestic Purposes) (Amendment)
Regulations 2006**

GN No. 175 of 2006

THE CENTRAL WATER AUTHORITY ACT

Regulations made by the Central Water Board under section 49 of the Central Water Authority Act

1. These regulations may be cited as the **Central Water Authority (Water Supply for Non-Domestic Purposes) (Amendment) Regulations 2006**.
2. In these regulations -

"principal regulations" means the Central Water Authority (Water Supply for Non-Domestic Purposes) Regulations 1992.
3. Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is amended in the definition of "monthly metered water supply" by deleting the words "between the reading of a meter made not less than twenty-five days nor" and replacing them by the words "as established by the reading of a meter made not".
4. Regulation 11(4) of the principal regulations is amended by inserting immediately after the word "discontinued" the following words "at meter".
5. The First Schedule to the principal regulations is amended -

(a) by adding immediately after item 2, the following new item -

2A METER RENT (Applicable to Tariff 53)

(b) in item 3,

(ii) in sub-item 3, in the heading, by deleting the words "and religious institutions";

(iii) by inserting immediately after sub-item (3), the following new sub-item

3(A) Tariff 53 (Applicable to Charitable and Religious Institutions)
