NOTIFICATION
by the President of the Assembly
(Under clause 5 of Annex I of Rules of Procedure of the Assembly)

Article V of the Framework Agreement of the International Solar Alliance (ISA) established a Secretariat to assist the ISA Members in their collective work under the Framework Agreement. The Secretariat comprises of a Director-General, who is the Chief Executive Officer, and other staff as may be required. The Director General is selected by and responsible to the Assembly, for a term of four years, renewable for a one further term (Article V (2) of the Framework Agreement).

As per the ISA, notification reference ISA/DG-selection/01/2024 dated 14 June 2024, it was notified that the four-year term of the incumbent Director-General will end on 14 March 2025, and the incumbent Director-General is not seeking renewal of his appointment for a further term.

Pursuant to the Rules of the Procedure of the Assembly (Clause 5 of Annex I), which provides the procedures for the selection of the Director-General, the appointment of an Expert Agency and a Selection Committee composed of up to four members, one each from every regional grouping as recommended by the Regional Committees, shall short-list three candidates from the nominations received for the post of the Director-General ISA.

I. Selection Committee

It is hereby notified that based on the nominations received, the Selection Committee shall comprise of the following members:


S.No.	Region	Member	Alternate Member
1	Asia & the Pacific Region	Bangladesh	Tonga
2	Africa Region	Ethiopia	Ghana
3	Latin America & the Caribbean Region	Guyana	Suriname
4	Europe & the Others Region	France	Sweden

It is further notified that the Member shall be a part of the Selection Committee. The Alternate Member shall become part of the Selection Committee under the following circumstances:

- a. The Member is unavailable due to some exigency.
- b. An application for the post of Director General, ISA, is received from an individual who is a national of the same country as the Member.

II. Expert agency

The expert agency assisting the Selection Committee in its task is Ernst and Young (EY), India.
